Contract

concerning an au pair employment between Au Pair and Host Family

According to the European Agreement on the Au Pair Employment of 24.11.1969

The following points are recognized by the contracting parties:

1. The host family undertakes to accept the au pair as their own daughter / son at the earliest from the time of issuing the visa with free meals and lodging, and to provide them with their own furnished room in their house / apartment for the duration of the stay.
2. The au pair receives a monthly allowance of 260 euros. The family pays the travel costs for the language course.
3. The au pair undertakes to stay with the host family for the duration of the stay, to help with childcare and light housework.
4. The continuation of the pocket money takes place in the case of illness until the expiry of the contract, however, at the latest 6 weeks.
5. The au pair may not accept any other paid work. The au pair undertakes to observe all laws and regulations of the country during the stay.
6. The host family undertakes to give the au pair the opportunity to attend a suitable language course, as well as to attend cultural and spiritual events. The host family helps the au pair to find their way around the new environment.
7. The au pair undertakes to accept the host family as his own family and to integrate as well as possible into the family community, to accept the children of the family as his own brothers and sisters and to respect and take care of them responsibly and lovingly.
8. The au pair undertakes to take responsibly and carefully the tasks assigned to him in the family.
9. The time required for the work may not exceed 6 hours on 5 days per week or 5 hours on 6 days per week, babysitting included. The time for the shared meals with the host family is not part of the working hours.
10. The au pair has at least one day per week, which falls on a weekend at least once a month. The au pair should have the opportunity to practice his religion.
11. During the stay, the host family will take care of the private health, accident and liability insurance for the au pair. The insurance application must be submitted immediately after the arrival date becomes known. Should the host family fail to do so, they must pay for all costs.
12. The host family bears the cost of renewing the visa and the health certificate that may be needed to renew the visa. If a health certificate is not required, it is still advisable to have the au pair be examined by a doctor after arrival. The costs are borne by the host family. The au pair agrees with this contract to the examination.

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13. The au pair receives 4 weeks of paid holidays for a 12-month stay. For a shorter stay 2 days per month of attendance as a paid holiday. During the holidays, Sundays are not considered vacation days. The host family should give the au pair the opportunity to participate in a family holiday together. In this case, it must be clearly agreed upon beforehand what proportion of the holiday and what proportion of the au pair activity will be assessed. If this is not possible, or not desired by the au pair, the au pair will have the opportunity to spend their holidays outside the family. If the family does not want to or cannot take the au pair on vacation, they are obliged to provide the au pair with accommodation and meals during this period, or they can reimburse the travel costs for a home leave to the au pair. Public holidays are generally free or compensated by free time.

14. This au pair contract can be terminated unilaterally with a notice period of 14 days. The contract termination must be in writing. The period begins upon receipt of notice of termination. In particularly serious cases a termination without notice is possible.

15. The host family undertakes to register the au pair properly with the registration office immediately upon arrival and to extend the visa for the entire duration of the planned au pair stay.

16. The au pair agrees to pay the travel expenses to the host family and back home

17. The au pair confirms that it is childless.

18. The au pair agrees to return immediately to the home country, after completion of the au pair time or after the termination of the contract.
